Earthquake of M:5.1 Occurred on 11th Jan 2021 in Jammu and Kashmir Region




Fig.1: Location and expected intensity of earthquake occurred on 11th January 2021.

- 1. An earthquake of magnitude M: 5.1 occurred in Doda, Jammu and Kashmir having epicentre at 33.34° N and 75.47° E and focal depth of 5 km at 19:32:04 IST on 11th January 2021. Epicenter is about 86 km North –East from Jammu, 100 km South- East of Srinagar, and about 120 km North of Pathankot. Location map of earthquake along with expected intensity is shown in Fig.1. The epicenter region lies in seismic Zone-IV as per seismic zoning map of India.
- 2. The area within 100 km radius from the epicenter of today's earthquake has experienced 7 earthquakes of magnitude 5.0 and above during past 20 years. The maximum magnitude of M: 5.6 occurred on 1st May 2013 which 27 km SE of present event.
- 3. Damage report (Cracks on walls) has been reported from Doda (Near epicentre). Felt report of Intensity II and III (MMI Scale) have been reported from a distance around 700 km and 300 KM from the epicenter respectively.
